Pursuant to Chapter III of the ABHES *Accreditation Manual*, Emergency Training Academy did not appeal the Commission's action to deny the institution's application for continued accreditation and to withdraw the current grant of accreditation. Therefore, this letter affirms the denial of the application and withdrawal of institutional accreditation for Emergency Training Academy, **effective February 27, 2023**, based on the items identified in the attached letter. It is noted that while the institution did provide the requested teach-out plan, ABHES did not receive the required exhibit, which requested a listing of all current students by program to include: mailing address; telephone number(s); email address(es); program start date; estimated completion date; total clock hours and/or credits earned to date; total clock hours and/or credits outstanding; and any financial responsibilities (unearned tuition, credit balance refund due, to whom the refund is due, or additional charges pending if tuition is not paid in full).

I.B.1.c. of the *Accreditation Manual* states that, within 60 days of the date of this letter, the Commission provides to the Secretary of the U.S. Department of Education, appropriate state agencies, recognized accrediting agencies, and the public a brief statement summarizing the reasons for this negative action and the official comments, if any, that your institution wishes to make with regard to this decision, or in the absence of official comment from your institution, evidence that the institution or program was offered the opportunity to provide official comment. **Consequently, if you wish to make a brief official written comment on this negative action you must do so within 10 calendar days of the date of this letter.** You are not required to make such statement, and failure to do so within the time allotted will be understood as a decision not to comment.

The U.S. Department of Education, the appropriate State licensing or authorizing agency, the appropriate accrediting agency, and the public have been notified of this action in compliance with 34 Code of Federal Regulations § 602.26 *et seq* and Chapter III of the *Accreditation Manual*.

The institution is reminded that it must, at this time, discontinue use of the ABHES logo, or any reference to ABHES accreditation in its publications, including the institutional website, catalog, and other print materials.
